Please indicate which scholarship(s) you intent to apply for.

- Bishop/High Scholarship (Scholarship Awards up to \$5000)  
Eligibility: Open to incoming freshmen and currently enrolled BDHS students with a minimum 3.0 GPA, good citizenship and participation in athletics or the arts, as well as financial need.  
*To apply please submit the completed FACTS Grant & Aid Application online and submit the required 250 word essay.*
- The Rodney Shull Memorial Scholarship (\$3,000 scholarship)  
Eligibility: Currently enrolled BDHS students who demonstrate good citizenship, have a minimum 3.0 GPA and participate in two or more sports.  
*To apply please submit the completed FACTS Grant & Aid Application online and submit the required 250 word essay.*
- The Mary Iannelli Memorial Scholarship (Two \$1000 awards presented annually)  
Eligibility: The first award will be presented to a BDHS sophomore or junior to be used for tuition assistance while at BDHS. The second award will be presented to a BDHS graduating senior to be used for college tuition. Both awards require a minimum 3.0 GPA.  
*To apply please submit the completed FACTS Grant & Aid Application online and submit the required 250 word essay.*
- The Charles and Margaret Kuehl Memorial Scholarship (\$500 scholarship)  
Eligibility: Open to an incoming freshman student. This award renews each year the student attends BDHS. Applicant must maintain good citizenship, a minimum 3.0 GPA, participation in at least one sport and demonstrate financial need.  
*To apply please submit the completed FACTS Grant & Aid Application on line and submit the required 250 word essay.*
- The Bishop Legacy Scholarship: (Awards range from \$1000 to \$5000)  
Eligibility: Open to Bishop Diego High School students (incoming and/or currently enrolled) who are the children or grandchildren of BDHS alumni. Students must have a minimum 3.0 G.P.A., good citizenship, financial need and participation in athletics or the arts.  
*To apply please submit the completed FACTS Grant & Aid Application online and submit the required 250 word essay.*
- Red Bird Scholarship: (Awards amounts range from \$1000 to \$10,000)  
Eligibility: Open to incoming and/or currently enrolled Bishop Diego High School students who demonstrate good citizenship, academic responsibility (minimum 2.5 G.P.A for returning students) and participate in two or more sports.  
*To apply please submit the completed FACTS Grant & Aid Application online and submit the required 250 word essay.*
