The California Association of Winegrape Growers offers a scholarship to honor the hard work of the men and women who help produce the highest quality winegrapes. At least three 4-year scholarships worth \$8,000 each and three 2-year scholarship worth \$2,000 each will be awarded. Additionally, they offer the Robert Miller Scholarship for Viticulture and Enology for students who plan to major in viticulture or enology at Cal Poly or Allan Hancock College.
